- Emergency Solutions Grant: Coronavirus - \$637,000 total available. (Funds expire July 30, 2022)
- Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP) – minimum of \$1,444.60 available for youth services; \$27,447.40 total available. (Funds expire June 30, 2021)

- Operating support for Emergency Housing Interventions (emergency shelters, navigation centers, street outreach, shelter diversion, homelessness prevention)
- Systems support to maintain and enhance coordinated entry system (CES), homeless management information system (HMIS), and homelessness planning activities
