The Sutter Yuba Homeless Consortium continues to manage the Coordinated Entry System for Yuba and Sutter Counties. The system identifies, assesses, refers and connects homeless individuals and/or families to housing or other needed services. Services provided at Coordinated entry include mental health counseling services, job skills and job search training, ready to rent classes, medical assessment and referrals, time and money management classes and more. Since the implementation of Coordinated Entry, 2,900 people were permanently housed through SYHC partners.
